Stage II Drought conditions have gone back to Stage I for all systems except Rocky Creek. The drought rates cease as of 1/20/2012 return to normal for these systems. This stage still requests a 10% reduction in your normal usage.

Customer Refunds

Since December 2008, Wiedefeld Water Works has over-charged for water due to a proposed water tariff that was filed with the TCEQ (state) and which was recently finalized at a lower rate than filed. Generally, all tariffs will revert back to pre December, 2008 rates, except when drought restrictions are imposed. For many of you this is \$4.00/mo. Until fully reimbursed. (June 2012)

Oak Ridge and Westwood customers will receive varying amounts per month. These refunds were approved by TCEQ in their final order and began being reflected in your October 2011 water bill. For most customers, these refunds will occur for 17 months. (April 2013)
